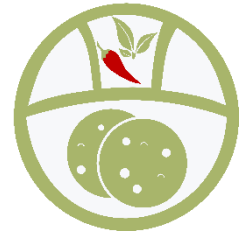

Employer will provide to the worker, without charge or deposit charge, all tools, supplies, and equipment

required to perform the duties assigned, in accordance with 20 CFR 655.20(k)

Employer will make all deductions from the worker's paycheck required by law. \$100/week deduction will be made from paycheck if staying at the employee provided housing.

Other Benefits: If the worker completes 50% of the work contract period, employer will reimburse the worker for transportation and subsistence. Upon completion of the work contract or where the worker is dismissed earlier, employer will provide or pay for worker's reasonable costs of return transportation and subsistence back home or to the place the worker originally departed to work, except where the worker will not return due to subsequent employment with another employer. The amount of transportation payment or reimbursement will be equal to the most economical and reasonable common carrier for the distances involved. The amount for daily subsistence will be at least \$12.68 per day during travel to a maximum of \$55.00 per day with receipts. Company will reimburse the H-2B worker in the first workweek for all visa, visa processing, border crossing, and other related fees, including those mandated by the government, incurred by the H-2B worker (doesn't include passport expenses) Optional lodging offered by employer @ \$100/week. Includes kitchen, living room and a shared room. Public transportation available to commute to work.
